Recognising the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.</p> <p>Measuring and time. Collecting data and knowing how to represent it.</p> <p>Fractions of numbers and quantities.</p>	<p>The children will be learning French this year as part of the modern foreign language curriculum.</p>	<p>Help your child with their homework and ensure that it is returned on time.</p> <p>Encourage your child to research the topics we are studying in their own time, by visiting the library or going onto the internet.</p> <p>Listen to your child read on a regular basis.</p> <p>Check your child has learned their times tables and spellings.</p>

<p>We will be investigating rocks and soils and their properties.</p> <p>In the second half of term we will be looking at plants and growth.</p>	<p>We shall be introducing and using a computer program called 'Scratch'. Through this program the children will learn to make simple animations with characters that move and make sound. In the second half of the term we shall be studying a unit called 'We are Bug Fixers' which will focus on finding and correcting bugs in computer systems.</p>	<p>We look at the Jewish beliefs about God. We will discuss the Creation Story according to the Jewish faith.</p>	<p><b>History</b> The first half of the term we are studying the historical time of the Stone Age to Iron Age in Britain. This will include looking at daily life and technology of the period.</p> <p><b>Geography</b> In the second half of the term we shall be developing mapping skills and studying two contrasting locations.</p>

<p>In PSHE our theme will be 'Proud to be Me' in the first half of the term. In the second half term the theme will be 'Healthy Lifestyle Choices'.</p> <p>The children will be developing speaking and listening skills and how to identify different types of questions.</p>	<p><b>Swimming</b> The children will partake in weekly swimming lessons every Tuesday.</p> <p><b>PE</b> PE lessons will take place on Thursday afternoons.</p>	<p><b>DT</b> We will be constructing hill forts as part of structures in Design &amp; Technology.</p> <p><b>Art</b> The children will develop their painting skills by painting still life and the natural world.</p>	<p>The children will be developing skills in performance and composition using a variety of untuned instruments. They will also be introduced to simple musical notation.</p>
