<p>This term, the children will learn:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •To confidently speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions •To begin to negotiate and solve problems without aggression •To explain own knowledge and understanding and ask appropriate questions of others •To initiate conversations and take and take account of what others say 	<p>This term, the children will learn:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action • To be able to follow a story without pictures or props • To use vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them • Continue a rhyming string 	<p>This term, the children will learn:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •To move freely in range of ways, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, walking, crawling, running, jumping, skipping, sliding •To hold pencil near point and two fingers and thumb with good control • To catch a large ball • To use one handed tools and equipment 	<p>Encourage your child to research the topics we are studying in their own time, by visiting the library or going on the internet.</p> <p>Bring in useful and relevant resources from home that we could use in the classroom.</p> <p>Come in and enjoy choosing a book with your child. Read with your children regularly.</p> <p>Do homework with your child and provide plenty of opportunities to draw and write.</p> <p>Please come and talk to us after school or book a mutually convenient time, if you have any queries.</p>

<p>This term, the children will learn to:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use phonic knowledge to read and write simple words and some irregular common words. To write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. <p>Over the term, we will be looking at a variety of texts, including stories, information books and poetry. A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Naughty Bus</i> • <i>The train ride</i> • <i>What the Ladybird heard</i> • Information texts about transport and animals 	<p>This term, the children will learn:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •To count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number • To find the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them •To recognise and describe 3D shapes • To order two items by weight 	<p>This term, the children will learn:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To talk about why things happen and how things work • To talk about significant events in their own experience • To name and sort modes of transportation •To talk about life cycles •To explore farm and jungle animals 	<p>This term, the children will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them. To safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. • Use what they have learnt about media and materials in original ways, thinking about uses and purposes. To represent their own ideas through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories.
