<p>Please continue to support your child with their homework each week.</p> <p>It is important in the run up to SATs that children complete homework, which will include revision and extra practise.</p> <p>When reading with your child, please use their red Reading Record. You can also write comments or ask questions about how they are doing in class.</p>	<p><b>Poetry</b> - Children will learn to create and use rhyming words in their writing. Build up rhyming sentences and lines for a poem.</p> <p><b>Fiction</b>-Children will read stories by significant authors. They will learn to write consistently in the present or past tense. They will continue to develop their understanding of punctuation.</p> <p><b>Non-Fiction</b> - Children will explore the difference between fact and fiction. Their writing will be linked to our history topic</p>	<p><b>Children will be covering a range of topics in preparation for their SATs:</b></p> <p><b>Addition and Subtraction</b> : mental and written strategies;  <b>Multiplication and Division:</b> mental and written strategies;  <b>Handling Data:</b> interpreting tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams;  <b>Fractions:</b> Recognise, name and write fractions 1/2, 1/4, 2/4, 3/4 and 1/3 using words and fraction notation;  <b>Time:</b> telling the time using an analogue clock to o'clock, half past, quarter past/quarter to;  <b>Position and direction:</b> describe turns clockwise and anti-clockwise;  <b>Money:</b> Consolidate recognising different coins (including £2) and notes (£5, £10, £20) and understand their value and use the symbols (£) and pence (p).</p>

<p><b>All Living Things:</b></p> <p><b>Plants</b> - We will learn about how plants grow and investigate what they need to stay healthy. Children will observe and measure growth of plants over time.</p> <p><b>Animals of the UK</b> - We will look at different habitats and how animals depend on their environment.</p>	<p><b>Questioning-</b> This unit is designed to help children learn about the importance of phrasing questions and that certain data handling resources are limited in the answers they can provide.</p> <p><b>Effective Searching-</b> children will learn skilful searching techniques</p>	<p><b>How do we know Easter is coming?-</b>In this unit children will be learning about the various events leading up to Easter. Easter is the most important festival for Christians across all different denominations (types of churches).</p> <p><b>Special Books-</b> In this unit, pupils will reflect on what books are special for themselves and why. They will then learn about the important place of books in religious traditions - Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism and Judaism</p>	<p><b>History-</b> The Great Fire of London Children will learn about how the fire started and the impact it had on London. They will learn about historic figures from that time and how they reacted to the Fire.</p> <p><b>Geography</b> - We will be learning about the Countries, which make up the UK. Children will use mapping and fieldwork to explore and map the local area.</p>
