<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions.• To begin to share experiences and play with a familiar friend or child with the same interests.• To participate within group activities.• To initiate conversations and take account of what others say.	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To understand action words (e.g. jumping, following) and carry out instructions.• To be able to follow a story with pictures or props.• To use vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them.• Continue a rhyming string.	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To move freely in range of ways, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, walking, crawling, running, jumping, skipping and sliding• To hold a pencil near point using two fingers and thumb with good control.• To catch a large ball.• To use one handed tools and equipment.	<p>Research topics we are studying with your child, by visiting the library or going on the internet.</p> <p>Bring in useful and relevant resources from home that we could use in the classroom.</p> <p>Read with your child regularly and encourage them to tell you what the story or book is about.</p> <p>Do homework with your child and provide plenty of opportunities to draw and write.</p> <p>Please come and talk to us after school or book a mutually convenient time, if you have any queries.</p>

<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To use phonic knowledge to read and write simple words and begin to write some irregular common words. <p>Over the term, we will be looking at a variety of texts, including stories, information books and poetry. A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Where the wild things are</i>• <i>Anansi the spider</i>• <i>Look Up</i>• <i>I am</i>	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To say numbers in order and notice numerals (number symbols) in the environment.• To recognise 2D shapes and make simple constructions with shapes.• To explore the size, height and weight of objects.	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To talk about things they have observed in their environment.• To talk about significant events in their own experience.• To discuss themselves and members of their family.	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them.• To create sounds by doing different actions (e.g. shaking, tapping).• To describe sounds and music imaginatively (e.g. funny or scary music).
