<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To recognise how their choices can affect others. • To discuss how others may be feeling and respond accordingly. • To participate within group activities. • To express a wide range of feelings in their interactions with others through behaviour and play. 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand why and how questions. • To respond to instructions with more elements • to understand prepositions (e.g. behind, in front). • To use vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them • Continue a rhyming string 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To balance on one foot or in a squat momentarily, shifting body weight to improve stability • To continue practicing to hold a pencil effectively to form letters and numbers. • To continue using different tools and equipment when cutting, writing etc. 	<p>Research topics we are studying with your child, by visiting the library or going on the internet.</p> <p>Bring in useful and relevant resources from home that we could use in the classroom.</p> <p>Read with your children regularly and encourage them to tell you what the story/book is about and what they liked or disliked.</p> <p>Do homework with your child and provide plenty of opportunities to draw and write.</p> <p>Please come and talk to us after school or book a mutually convenient time, if you have any queries.</p>

A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>The Magic Paintbrush</i> • <i>Super Milly and the Super School</i> • <i>The Tiny Seed</i> • <i>I will not ever never eat a tomato</i> 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To recognise symbols and add/subtract amounts of objects. • To identify similarities and differences in 2D & 3D shapes. • To understand language of position and direction. • To sequence events 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To talk about why things happen and how things work • To talk about significant events in their own experience • To name and sort modes of transportation • To explore farm and jungle animals 	<p>This term, the children will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them. • Create sounds by doing different actions (e.g. shaking, tapping). • Begin to describe sounds and music imaginatively (e.g. funny or scary music).
