<p><b>This term, the children will learn to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use phonics knowledge to write initial sounds of words.</li> <li>• Use a keyboard to find letters in their name.</li> <li>• Fill in the missing words or phrases in known rhymes and stories.</li> </ul> <p>Over the term, we will be looking at a variety of texts, including stories, information books and poetry. A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Willy the Wimp</li> <li>• The Night Pirates</li> <li>• So Much</li> <li>• Oi Frog</li> </ul>	<p><b>This term, the children will learn to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognise numbers to 10.</li> <li>• Link numerals to amounts of objects.</li> <li>• Create patterns using different shapes.</li> <li>• To compare two groups of objects using more, lots, the same.</li> </ul>	<p><b>This term, the children will learn:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To discuss similarities and differences between friends and family.</li> <li>• To sort modes of transportation</li> <li>• To understand important changes in the world (e.g. the seasons).</li> <li>• To explore the natural world through observations and drawings.</li> </ul>	<p><b>This term, the children will learn to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To use different materials, tools and techniques and experiment with colours to create objects.</li> <li>• To discuss the process used to make a new creation.</li> <li>• To perform songs, rhymes and poems use actions in time to the music.</li> </ul>
