<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To express their feelings, show an understanding of others feelings and show sensitivity to the needs of others. • Show focused attention when engaging in an activity and follow instructions involving several actions. • Work cooperatively with others. • Try new activities and show independence, resilience and perseverance if challenges arise. 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To listen attentively and respond in discussions with comments, questions and actions during reading or class discussions. • To participate in discussions expressing their own ideas, using new vocabulary and using past, present and future tenses. 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To demonstrate balance and coordination when doing different activities. • To move around obstacles safely and be mindful of others around them. • To practice using the tripod grip when writing. 	<p>Research topics we are studying with your child, by visiting the library or going on the internet.</p> <p>Bring in useful and relevant resources from home that we could use in the classroom.</p> <p>Read with your children regularly and encourage them to tell you what the story/book is about and what they liked or disliked.</p> <p>Do homework with your child and provide plenty of opportunities to draw and write.</p> <p>Please come and talk to us after school or book a mutually convenient time, if you have any queries.</p>

<p>This term, the children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use phonic knowledge to read and write simple words. • To read and write some irregular common exception words. • To retell known stories in their own words. <p>Over the term, we will be looking at a variety of texts, including stories, information books and poetry. A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Willy the Wimp • The Night Pirates • So Much • Oi Frog 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To recall number bonds to 5 and some to 10. • To count beyond 20. • To compare quantities to 10 (using vocabulary such as more/less than) • To explore odd and even numbers, doubling facts and sharing amounts equally. 	<p>This term, the children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To discuss similarities and differences between different religions. • To understand important changes in the world (e.g. the seasons). • To explore the natural world through observations and drawings. 	<p>This term, the children will learn :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To use different materials, tools and techniques and experiment with colours to create objects. • To discuss the process used to make a new creation. • To perform songs, rhymes and poems use actions in time to the music.
