Identify simple nets of 3D shapes Solve problems involving length, mass, capacity.</p>	<p>Magnet and Forces: Children will be taught how things move on different surfaces and observe how magnets attract or repel each other.</p> <p>Science week: In the second half term we will be investigating and experiencing various parts of science.</p>	<p>Help your child with their homework, ensure that it is signed by a Parent/Carer and returned on time. Encourage your child to research the topics we are studying in their own time, by visiting the library or going onto the internet. Listen to your child read on a regular basis. Check your child has learned their multiplication times tables and spellings.</p>

<p>The Tudor Explorers: In the second half term children will explore British history from the Reformation to the expansion of the British Empire. We will be looking at the causes and consequences of both events in history.</p>	<p>Life in the big Smoke: In the first half term we will be investigating countries and cities around the world, we will also study in depth two regions: Canada and Bangladesh.</p>	<p>Branching Databases: Children will be introduced to Branching Databases which is sometimes known as 'binary tree' or 'key' and will classify a group of objects.</p> <p>Graphing / Simulations: Children will be able to set up a graph and solve an investigation. They will also be introduced to simulations - a program that models a real-life or imaginary situations.</p>	<p>Sikh Beliefs: The children find out about 6 main Sikh symbols and their meaning to Sikh people.</p> <p>Jesus and Buddha: Children will explore stories told by Jesus and Buddha to see how they challenged people at the time and still do today.</p>
